

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter consists of two parts. The first part is Conclusions based on research findings and the second part is suggestions based on Conclusions.

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the findings and discussion in the previous chapter, the author can outline several conclusions as follows: The use of Canva media is effectively used in teaching in class VIII at SMP Negeri 1 Makale Utara Language Film. This is proven by the post-test average value being higher than the pre-test average value ($75.33 > 50.67$) and the t-test results, the calculated t-value is higher than the t-table value (8.95 0,3610). This shows that Canva media is effectively used in the teaching and learning process in class VIII of SMP Negeri 1 Makale Utara.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the results of data analysis and conclusions, the author provides several suggestions as follows:

For teachers:

In teaching the use of Canva media, the author suggests using Canva media in the teaching process in class, because it has been proven that using Canva learning media can improve student learning outcomes. Therefore, teachers must prepare themselves well. This means that they must prepare appropriate materials to teach to students before they enter the classroom.

For Students:

Students are advised to broaden their insight in utilizing learning media such as Canva, Capcut, Kinmaster and other media. Students can also be independent in the learning process, and they will feel comfortable in learning if they understand the benefits of the learning media they are studying.

For Other Researchers:

Considering the limitations that the author encountered, it is necessary to carry out further research with a larger sample size. This will help obtain more data, confirm the findings and allow more concrete conclusions to be drawn regarding the effects of using Canva media in English language teaching. Additionally, a longer experimental period is needed so researchers can draw more valid conclusions and see if improvements are consistent.
